## **Financial Aid:**

<u>Scholar Retention Program-</u> provides funding for students who have been academically disqualified to come back and take classes in summer and apply for re-admission. Coordinator: Natalie Gonzalez Email: <u>natalie\_gonzalez@ucsb.edu</u>

<u>Financial Aid Crisis Team</u>- responds to students within 24-48hrs and provides immediate short term loans for students in crisis. Coordinator: Rebecca Plotkin Email: <u>rebecca.plotkin@sa.ucsb.edu</u>

<u>Student Emergency Medical Relief Fund (SMERF</u>) - provides up to \$3,000 in medical emergency funds for students who don't have access to Gaucho Health Insurance or can't cover a medical expense. (See Rebecca Plotkin above)

## **Housing:**

<u>EOP Emergency Housing Grant</u>- for low income students under threat of eviction (also see Financial Aid Crisis)

<u>Emergency Shelter/Transitional Living</u>- emergency housing for students with no family or friends in the area. (Financial Aid Crisis)
